You now have the option to file the biennial report online by using a Visa or MasterCard. All you need to do is go to the website listed above and click on the link "File Biennial Report Online". Enter the Alaska Entity # listed above and follow the step-by-step process to complete the report.

If you do not want to file your report online, you can print the report from our website and click on "Search Corporations Database". Once you have brought up the entity record you will see link to print a blank biennial report at the top of the results page.

If you do not have Internet access you may call our report request line at 907-465-8530. Please leave a message with the name of the entity, the entity number, and the fax number or mailing address of where you want the report to be sent.

The corporation has an opportunity for a hearing on the dissolution or revocation. A request for a hearing must be in writing and be received within sixty days after the receipt of this notice. The written request for the hearing must specify statutory grounds the appealing party believes to be a basis for stay of revocation.
