The Bills also dealt with tragedy when tight end Kevin Everett suffered a spinal-cord injury in a season-opening loss to Denver. Everett, one of Taylor's teammates at the University of Miami, is recuperating at his home in Houston. He has regained limited use of his legs after an initial prognosis that he would never walk again.

Jason Campbell had personal-best performances in the last two games, and the Bills have given up the fourth-most passing yards in the league. Despite its losing streak, Washington has been more productive since Coach Joe Gibbs opened up the game plan offensively. This isn't the time to go back into a shell.

Gregg Williams Is Adept at Bamboozling Quarterbacks, And Buffalo Is Starting Trent Edwards, a Rookie

"We're going to have some similar play concepts . . . from the last few weeks, some other different things there, too," Redskins' Gregg Williams said.

Advantage, Defense

The Buffalo Bills have grown accustomed to changes at quarterback. Injuries prompted Coach Dick Jauron to name J.P. Losman and rookie Trent Edwards as starters at different points this season. After Losman struggled in last week's 36-14 loss to Jacksonville, Jauron quickly announced Edwards would start against the Redskins today at FedEx Field. Gregg Williams, the Redskins' assistant head coach-defense and a former Buffalo head coach, is considered among the league's best at making things difficult for quarterbacks, and it figures he'll try to keep the inexperienced Edwards guessing.
