Protest being monitored, local Afghan killed

KABUL, Afghanistan (Jan. 28) – IJC is monitoring the situation outside of Camp Phoenix in Kabul as initial reports indicate a crowd gathered to protest ISAF operations.

We can confirm one civilian was killed by ISAF forces this morning during an incident involving an ISAF convoy. The specific details of the incident are not known at this time. ISAF is conducting a thorough investigation in cooperation with our ANSF partners.

“We deeply regret the tragic loss of life that occurred this morning, and extend our most sincere sympathies to the family,” said Navy Capt. Jane Campbell, ISAF Joint Command spokesperson.

More details will be released as they become available.
