[redacted] was interviewed in New York City on December 1, 1964. He stated that in [redacted] he was apprehended by a member of [redacted]

[redacted]

[redacted] stated he has been associated with Mr. Valenti on a limited basis for the past twelve or fifteen years in Texas and California. They have attended parties together at which they had female dates. [redacted] stated he stayed in Mr. Valenti's apartment on two occasions, once while Mr. Valenti was present and another time when Mr. Valenti was away. He stated that, to his knowledge, Mr. Valenti has never engaged in homosexual activities and he does not have these tendencies. [redacted] stated that because of mental and physical exhaustion, he is unable to furnish a signed statement regarding the information he has furnished. He added that he would not sign a statement without first consulting his attorney.
